Norwich City Council Half Term Activities



Norwich City Council are also offering cycling opportunities in Lakenham and Tuckswood over half term. They are organising a fun cycling session on **Thursday 2nd June** between 2-4pm at Harford Park. This will be a free drop in for children to come and learn some skills, build confidence on the bike, play some games and have some fun races on the cycle speedway track. They will also have the Bike Doctor there to carry out bike checks and a limited number of bikes to borrow for any children who don't have their own.

On **Sunday 5th June** at 10am, they are also arranging a Schools Skyride. Norwich City Council have secured a team of Ride Leaders to deliver a schools/family ride, this will start at Lakenham Primary School. This is a chance for families to join a group ride, led by qualified British Cycling ride leaders. There will be rides of different lengths (1.5 miles up to 6 miles) to suit varying ages and abilities.
