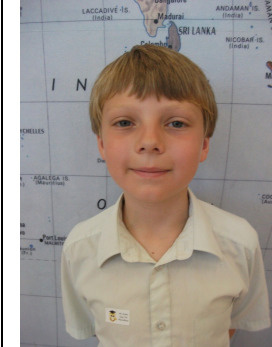
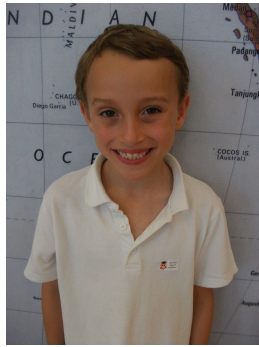

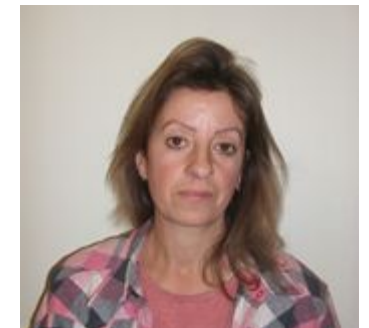


Well done to our 'Celebration Assembly' certificate winners - keep up the good work!
