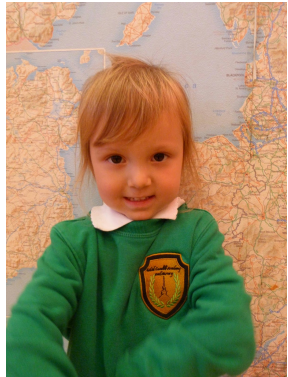

Thank you to all the parents who have got their children to school on time this week. We have had a noticeable improvement - we had **12 children** arriving late to school this week.

Unfortunately a number of children are not being collected from school at 3.15pm and parents haven't booked them into after school club. This is incurring extra staff costs. We are introducing a **fine system** when parents have not collected by 3.25pm. Any parents who are late picking up their child will be issued a fine of **£1.00** to cover additional staff costs. This will increase to £2.00 if children have still not been collected by 3.45pm.

It is distressing for children if they are left at school and do not know where their parents are. It is parents responsibility to ensure their children are collected on time. In an emergency, please ensure the school is notified urgently.
